III Forum of the Baltic States Wind Orchestra Conductors and Ensemble Leaders

Arts Education and Intangible Heritage Centre (AEIHC) invites you to the III Forum of the Baltic States Wind Orchestra Conductors and Ensemble Leaders taking place from 15th to 16th October, 2011, in Riga, Jäzeps Vītols Latvian Academy of Music.

The first Forum of the Baltic States Wind Orchestra Conductors and Ensemble Leaders was organized in 2009, inviting to take part in a number of master classes, attend concerts and visit the exhibition. The forum has been highly appreciated by Leon Bly, the President of the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (WASBE) in 2010, particularly stressing the role of the event in developing the sector of wind bands in the region of Baltic States.

The third Forum of the Baltic States Wind Orchestra Conductors and Ensemble Leaders can be seen as a tradition since holding the main structure of the event — master classes, concerts, exhibitions. The participants will be additionally offered a variety of other activities being presented by the professionals of the Netherlands, Austria, Germany, Lithuania, Estonia and Latvia. The programme of the concerts will be formed by music from the Baltic States, Belgium and the Netherlands. The special guests of the forum will be the only orchestra occasionally performing on the horses — the Wind Band of Tuva Republic Government that will provide a variety of local music performed according to the traditions of the region.

All the participants of the forum after paying participation fee and taking part in the master classes will receive a certificate issued by AEIHC.
